

## 139<sup>th</sup> Victorian Championships (2014)

By the look on twenty-three year old Matt Pozzebon's face when he got up from 1000 yards on the last day of The Queen's, you would have thought he'd just put a shot on the wrong target. You would never have guessed he was about to win the 2014 Victorian Queen's! He waited until the last shot at the last range of the last day to prove he was human, by dropping his one and only point to finish with 399.38 centres. It's thought that Matt is the youngest ever Victorian Queen's winner so he hasn't left himself much room for improvement. His preparation for the event was interrupted by being quite ill the week before. Fortunately he had the Teams matches and The Syme to run into form.

But back to where it all started. VRA Treasurer Peter Doig, and VRA Life Member Colleen Morgan (pictured below) headed the organisation of the event. Having the National Teams event added to the mix increased the magnitude of that task but the bonus was the additional entries for the following Victorian Championships.

There were 182 entries for The Syme (130TR/52F) and 266 entries for The Queen's (178TR/88F) including visitors from New Zealand and the UK. Numbers for both events were not only well up on last year but the best entry for many years (hence the smile on Treasurer Peter's face above). It was also the first time that F/TR was included and we look forward to seeing a growth in that category.

The stats team of Frank, Alan and Garry (pictured below) had an added difficulty this year because we ran the old reliable (according to Frank!) VRA stats system alongside the new NRAA stats system, with much assistance from Catherine Berry. This was the first time the new NRAA system was run completely live. Quite a few very favourable comments were received during the event noting that results were loaded onto the VRA website usually within half an hour of the range finishing.
