TRA, TRB, TRC, FSA, FSB, FO, FTR, PC, PCO (ALL grades catered for)

Every Rifle Club in Australia is eligible to enter

Top 25% in all grades will receive Badges (Special 140th Year Anniversary Badges)

Nomination Forms will be sent to Club Captains via email.

The Club will nominate their shooters, their grades and one email address. ALL communication from clubs will be via their nominated email address, communication via any other email address will not be accepted.

Payment for the shoot will be via bank transfer to the Armidale Rifle Club bank account with nominations.

- ✓ **Scoring with HEXTA systems** – A copy of the shooters target history for that range will be sent to the Armidale Rifle Club via their email.
- ✓ **Scoring with Silver Mountain/Shotmarker /Konnensburg**– A screen shot of the competitors string will be emailed to the Armidale Rifle Club via email.
- ✓ **Manual Targets** – A photo of the target and score card signed by the Club Captain can be sent to the Armidale Rifle Club via email.

Results will not be accepted after 7pm (8th November 2025)

Results will be published on the Armidale Rifle Club Facebook Page and emailed to Club Captains. Competition will be conducted under the SSR using ICFRA targets.

ET Shoot Competition Rules and Regulations

1. To be shot between 12.00pm and 5.00pm local time on the day nominated
2. A competitor can only have one visit to the mound on that day in this competition
3. Competition will be conducted at 600 metres on Metric ranges and 600 yards on Imperial ranges using ICFRA Targets.
4. 1 x 20 shot match with 2 x NON-Convertible sighters. Time allowed 30 minutes
5. Clubs will send results from nominated email address. Organisers will NOT accept results from Non-Nominated Emails.
6. Results will be sent via email (Photos of targets, screen shot and results website address).
7. Paper targets will number shots on target and score cards to be photographed (write shot number next to the bullet hole with white markers) and signed by the Club Captain.
8. Clubs will transfer monies (\$25 per shooter) to Armidale Rifle Club Account for shooters nomination at least 3 days prior to the competition.

9. The competition will be conducted under SSR.
10. Badges will be awarded to the top 25% in Grade or Class.
11. If shooter does not have a grading the Club Captain will issue a grading from Club Results.
12. Results will be posted on the Armidale Rifle Club Facebook page.
13. Results must be sent by email by 7.00pm local time.
14. Organisers reserve the right to change program.
15. Shooting order will be determined by the Club Captain.
16. If two shooters have the same score a countback will be undertaken to decide winners. If shooters cannot be separated by countback, the first shooters results in will be the winner. Then one shooter will get #1 badge, the next one 1st, then 3rd etc.

Proceeds are to go to the UNDER 25'S F Open side (Bisley August 2026) and the UNDER 25'S TR side (Belmont August 2026).
